

2021 Falesco Vitiano Bianco Italy



A 50% Vermentino and 50% Verdicchio blend from Orvieto, Umbria. The Cotarella family started their first winery in the 1960's, and Falesco in 1979. Since then, they've opened up multiple estates in central Italy, including Est! Est! Est! and "Montiano" in Lazio, as well as in Umbria. A young vineyard, growing in sedimentary rock, clay, and limestone. The Vermentino and Verdicchio are harvested at separate times, with the Vermentino being harvested first. The juice is "cryomacerated" with the skins for up to 5 hours prior to fermentation. This technique lends itself to texture. Fermented in stainless steel and finished a few months in the bottle before release. This wine is fresh, with elegant softness, and lingering fruit-forward aromas of pear and lime. The minerals and freshly cut white flowers pop out of the glass. Pair this with salads, shellfish, or as an aperitif.

2019 Geyser Peak Red Blend California



A blend of 66% Zinfandel, 12% Syrah, 11% Merlot, and 11% Malbec. Since its establishment in 1880 as California's 29th bonded winery, Geyser Peak has been at the forefront of quality wine production since its earliest days. Founded by a pioneer of Alexander Valley winemaking, the original winery site was selected for its relation to The Geysers, discovered only 33 years prior. The winery was perched on a hillside, commanding a view of Geyser Peak Mountain and the white steam that billowed from its peaks. The majority of the Proprietary Red Blend was sourced from Sonoma County and was aged for 18 months in French Oak barrels. On the nose this wine impresses with rich red fruit intensity, hints of baking spice and warm French toast. Medium-bodied, the palate is balanced and smooth, offering mature flavors and a long, enjoyable finish. Pairs well with savory dishes, hearty soups, grilled red meats and pasta dishes

2020 Chateau Argadens Blanc Bordeaux, France



A blend of 65% Sauvignon Blanc and 35% Semillon. Owned by the Sichel family since 2002, this chateau is situated in the south of the Entre-deux-Mers. Aged in stainless steel tanks. With its fine balance between Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon, this wine shows the ripeness of the vintage allied to crisp green fruits and gooseberry flavors. Fresh and expressive on the nose, with superb notes of pink grapefruit, mango and some slightly toasted hints. Its fine balance on the palate is remarkable, with a lot of roundness and body, as well as pure, elegant freshness. The flavours of Sauvignon are delicate and persistent, giving this wine length and vibrancy. A structured wine, it will continue to develop well over the years. Pair with chicken, sauteed scallops, crab, pork tenderloin, and roasted squash.

Meadowcroft “Anniversary Cuvee” Red Blend Napa Valley



A Bordeaux-style blend of Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Malbec. Meadowcroft Wines are vineyard specific and limited in production, expressing both European wine heritage and California creativity. Meadowcroft is the namesake of Winegrower Tom Meadowcroft, With over thirty-five years of experience in viticulture and winemaking. The meaning of Meadowcroft is a fertile field or meadow and croft refers to a cultivated area that has been nurtured over time. The honeybee on the label symbolizes this conscientious work and the process of transformation from wine grapes into an outstanding wine. This special production red blend features splendid aromas of spiced plum and blackberries with a hint of roasted red pepper. The tannins are well integrated on the supple, smooth palate, showcasing brambly, dark fruit flavors with a jammy finish laced with

allspice, graphite, and raspberry jam. Pair with ribeye steak and mushroom risotto.

2019 Stag's Leap "The Investor" Red Blend Napa Valley



The Investor is a red wine that beautifully blends together the unique flavors and expressions of Merlot, Petite Sirah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec, resulting in a powerful, yet approachable assemblage with significant fruit presence. A true compliment of the winery's ability to combine power with grace, the 2019 Investor is warm, rich, and inviting, with exuberant notes of dark blackberry, black cherry, blueberry cobbler, and dark plum, alongside spiced notes of cinnamon, clove, allspice and vanilla. Alluring notes of black pepper, graphite, and floral violet are interwoven with delicate savory notes of fresh thyme, lavender and wild sage. The plush mouthfeel is silky and inviting with round tannins that envelope the palate, leading to a long, mouthwatering finish with fresh acidity and vibrancy. Accompany alongside any dish to enliven any celebratory meal.

2019 Terroir Coquerel Petite Sirah Napa Valley



Coquerel Family Wine Estates is located just beyond the town of Calistoga at the north end of the Napa Valley. The heart and soul of our winery is our estate vineyard, a gorgeous, oak-studded property that sits in the afternoon shadows of the Mayacamas Mountains. Since 2005, we have done extensive enhancement and replanting of the site to ensure world-class fruit from vintage to vintage. The grapes were de-stemmed, crushed, cold macerated for 24 hours and punched down throughout fermentation to extract as much flavor as possible. The wine was then pressed, barreled before malolactic fermentation and aged 20 months in French oak (25% new). Our 2019 Petite Sirah from the “Walnut Wash Vine-

yard” has a nice dark color. The nose has a note of black berries. The palate is dense with soft tannin and a long finish of red cherry. It will pair perfectly with cheese, meat dishes. While this wine drinks beautifully now it will continue to improve over the next decade.
