

2023 Leda 'Truffle Hunter' Bianco Piedmont, Italy



A blend of 60% Arneis, 20% Chardonnay, 10% Riesling, and 10% Moscato. This label is a tribute to the Bosio family's beloved dog 'Leda' – a Lagotto Romagnolo, a breed from the Romagna sub-region of Italy bred for hunting truffles. The grapes for this wine come from vineyards located in the Langhe sub-region and Roero region, at 200-to-400 ft. above sea level. The grapes spend 24 hours at low temperature in contact with the skin to increase the complexities of the aromas. The wine spent five months in contact with its own yeasts after fermentation. The nose is clean and floral with captivating aromas of pineapple, apricot and peach that follow through to the palate and refreshing finish. Pair with seared scallops in a citrus butter, roasted chicken, butternut squash ravioli, and creamy cheeses.

2023 Giapoza Pinot Noir California



A true family affair, the Pozzan family created Giapoza to celebrate their winemaking family's newest member, and 5th generation, Gianna Pozzan. Behind every good man is a great woman. Such was the case with Michael and Mary Ann. Mary Ann Giannini is a Bay Area native whose family was familiar with the Pozzan's. She motivated Michael to start the winery and the two of them ran every aspect of the business for years. In fact, it wasn't until their oldest son Dante joined the business that they had another full time employee. Aromas of raspberry, cranberry, and rose petal. In the mouth, the wine shows flavors of fresh strawberries, candied orange peel, and caramel, with cinnamon and cloves perfuming the lengthy finish. Pair with lamb, duck, mushroom risotto, BBQ chicken and ribs, and grilled salmon.

2024 Zenato Trebbiano San Benedetto, Lugana, Veneto



Founded in 1960 by Sergio & Carla Zenato, the history of the Zenato winery began with Sergio Zenato pioneering development of the banks of Lake Garda, championing the region's native white varietal, Trebbiano di Lugana. With a passion for the land and a commitment to vigorous research, innovation, and quality improvement, Sergio Zenato strived to craft wines that are known for their quality and consistency. The second generation now carries on the family legacy. Made from 100% Trebbiano di Lugana harvested from the San Benedetto parcel on the south shore of Lake Garda. The grapes are fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks and refined for six months before being released. Notes of peaches, citrus, bananas, and herbs, which are underscored by crisp acidity and supple body on the palate. Pair with seafood antipasti, pan fried fish, pasta with seafood, and quiche.

2022 Sarreau-Martin Tradition Castillon Côtes de Bordeaux, France



A blend of 90% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 5% Cabernet Franc. Our vineyards are situated in a prime area of the appellation, adjacent to the renowned St. Émilion district of Bordeaux. This well balanced cuvée exhibits the characteristics of the region. Clay-limestone soils make up the vineyards of Sarreau-Martin typical of Saint-Emilion and Côtes de Castillon. This soil of clay mixed with limestone rocks make for a perfect environment for raising Merlot on the right bank of the Dordogne. Ripe tannins and layers of spice lie within this rich wine's black-currant fruits. The wine is juicy and perfumed, dominated by Merlot, and with an open texture. Pair with grilled lamb, beef, duck, eggplant parmesan, or even your favorite pizza.

2022 Truchard Cabernet Sauvignon Carneros, Napa Valley



A blend of 88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc, 1% Petit Verdot and 1% Malbec. The Truchard Estate Vineyard is located in the Carneros region of the Napa Valley. It is 400 acres of rolling hills and valleys that contain a variety of soils: clay, shale, sandstone, limestone, volcanic ash and rock. The combinations of terrain, geology and marine-moderated temperatures provide ideal growing conditions for wine-grapes. The wine was then aged for 20 months in French oak barrels (45% new). Perfumed aromas of wild blackberries, violets and tobacco leaves. The palate is full-bodied with firm tannins and acidity, giving notes of blackcurrants, cedar and dried herbs. Pair with braised short ribs, grilled ribeye, aged gouda, and smoked tofu.

2022 Clif Family 'Reyna' Red Blend Napa Valley



A blend of 49% Zinfandel, 39% Cabernet, 7% Petite Sirah, and 5% Malbec. We were captivated by Miami-based artist Reyna Noriega and the way her work blends colors, themes and stories to create a compelling experience. This red blend comes from our new, CCOF certified Valle Di Sotto vineyard in the heart of the Oak Knoll District of Napa Valley. The Oak Knoll District is located at the southern end of the Valley where cooling marine influences create a unique micro-climate that helps the grapes maintain bright fruit flavors and retain acidity. Ripe and jammy notes of plum, wild strawberry and cherry. The palate has medium weight tannin and you can feel the Cabernet in the middle with its broad scope. Pair with BBQ, pasta with red sauce, pulled pork, osso buco, and grilled hot Italian sausages.
