

2020 S. Osvaldo Pinot Grigio Della Venezia, Italy



Founded by Baron Lajos Babos in the 1930's, the winery was named after Oswald of Northumbria, the Patron Saint of the small hamlet where the winery lies in Loncon di Annone Veneto. The winery was purchased by the Serena family in 2004, where they have continued the love and dedication to the land and its vines that Babos started a half century before. D.O.C. Delle Venezie (Eastern Veneto Region)

Tasting Notes: Lively aromas and flavors of tropical fruits, pear and citrus. Smooth and delicate mouthfeel with balanced acidity and a lingering finish. A fantastic wine to be enjoyed throughout the warmer months of spring and summer.

Try pairing this wine with salads, soft cheese and shellfish.

2019 Valderba Tempranillo Aragon, Spain

2020 Emilio Moro “Polverete” Godello Bierzo, Spain



The history of Bodegas Emilio Moro dates back three generations. The grandfather of the third generation of Emilio Moro was born in 1891, and his son, Emilio Moro, was born in 1932. Both were born into a wine growing environment, surrounded by vineyards. They grew up treading grapes in their hometown of Pesquera de Duero in the province of Valladolid. Emilio Moro instilled in his son a love of wine and his son, in turn, passed this on to the third generation, who currently manage the winery.

Polvorete is a wine born to make the wonders of the Godello grape known the world over. A wine full of joy, youth and fun, which is above all easy to enjoy. Straw yellow in color. The nose is subtle and elegant, with notes of the Godello variety, highlighting white flowers. The palate is fresh with balanced acidity.

2019 Airfield Estates “Dauntless” Red Wine Yakima Valley, Washington



Airfield Estates is a fourth generation family farm based in the Yakima Valley cultivating a wide range of premium grapes and crafting estate grown wines of exceptional quality. As the name suggests, Airfield Estates has ties to aviation. A portion of the family property operated as a training base for hundreds of Army Air Corps pilots during World War II. The pride, passion, and dedication of these heroes provide a great source of inspiration as we strive to pay tribute to them with our wines. A classic Right Bank Bordeaux Style Blend of 69% Merlot, 17% Cabernet Sauvignon and 14% Cabernet Franc. The final blend consisted of aging in 100% French Oak for 15 months, with 25% being new French oak and 35% 1 to 3-year-old French oak and 40% Neutral Oak. This fine Bordeaux blend presents an array of black current, boysenberry, and toasted oak with firm tannins that carry through to a long finish

2020 Lola Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley



LOLA is a Napa Valley based boutique winery focused on creating high quality, approachable and affordable wines. Our winemaking approach pays tribute to the old-world tradition with carefully selected vineyards and handcrafted wines made in small batches. For us, growing grapes and making wine is about connecting with nature, working alongside the ever-changing elements, year to year, to make wines that represent their true sense of place. The Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced mostly from Calistoga. The wine shows an intensely dark ruby color with aromas of red plum, black cherry and currant gracing the nose. On the palate, firm structure and natural tannin provide a gripping intense mouth-feel

falling of into a long supple finish. This wine will continue to get better and better as the years go by and will age beautifully for years.

2018 Judge Palmer Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma Valley



Emmitt-Scorsone Winegrowers is a partnership between winemakers Palmer Emmitt and Michael Scorsone. At our small artisan winery in northern Sonoma County, we bottle wines under several labels – Judge Palmer, Domenica Amato, and Emmitt-Scorsone. Across the portfolio, our grapes are sourced from small, family-owned vineyards and our wines hand-made with passion and authenticity. Named after Palmer's grandfather, Judge Palmer showcases Cabernet Sauvignon and other varietal wines made in the classic California tradition from premier vineyards in both Napa and Sonoma. The Cabernet for the 2018 edition of this wine was sourced from the Ellis Alden Vineyard in Alexander Valley (70%) and our Estate Vineyard (30%) in Dry Creek Valley. A bright, expansive nose announces this wine packed with warm currant, red licorice and berry compote flavors around a core of loamy earth and subtle spice character.

Complex and structured to last, the palate features silky smooth tannins weaved with firm acidity. Try this wine the next time you throw a steak on the BBQ!
