

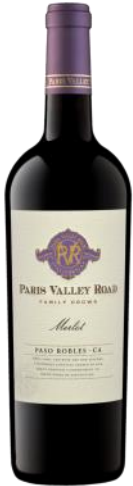
2021 M. Dean Chardonnay California



Made by the former winemaker of Joel Gott, Alisa “AJ” Jacobson, the founder M. Dean, Michael Dean has developed a great reputation as a wine importer for over 35 years. Known for bringing impeccable wines to wine lovers across the country, now he brings you M. Dean, a California name you can trust to deliver similarly high-quality wines with exceptional value. The Chardonnay was pressed to tank, settled, and racked where it began fermentation. One third of the wine underwent malolactic fermentation. The wine finished fermenting in French oak barrels (25% new) and aged for 10 months to create a rounded character on the palate. Pair with fish, pasta, poultry, and veggies.

2020 Paris Valley Road Merlot Central Coast



A blend of 82% Merlot, and 18% Cabernet Sauvignon. Paris Valley Road showcases the very best of Paso Robles, a world-renowned wine region, in our destination winery, estate vineyard, and event space. Inspired by the great domaines of France, here you can taste a wide variety of our Bordeaux-inspired wines among the breathtaking views of Paso Robles' hillsides and the gentle scent of lavender. Made using traditional winemaking fermentation practices, this Merlot is aged in 30% new French oak for 18 months. This juicy Merlot opens with deep aromas of blueberry and black cherry with notes of cinnamon spice. On the palate, ripe flavors of plum, blackberry and cassis are complemented with sleek tannins and a structured finish. Pair with steak, pasta, and cheeses, as well as roasted vegetables and charcuterie.

2022 Three By Wade Chenin Blanc California



The Wilson family has been farming the rich land in Clarksburg for four generations, beginning with George Harold Wilson who established the family homestead in the early 20th century. The vineyard is situated one hour northeast of Napa Valley, and is made up of mostly silt and loam soils. With the San Francisco Bay and the Pacific Ocean to the west, and the Sacramento River to the east, fog and cool breezes keep this region cool. Our 2022 Three by Wade Blanc comes from organically farmed vines in Clarksburg, California. It is fermented with 100% native yeast and aged in 30% neutral French oak and 70% stainless steel. On the nose, this wine has aromas of jasmine and fresh lemon, while the palate has notes of ripe pear with a clean bright finish. It carries refreshing acidity and minerality with medium body. Pair with sushi, salads with vinaigrettes, or even some Asian-inspired cuisines.

2020 Noceto Sangiovese Shenandoah Valley, CA



The California Shenandoah Valley is an American Viticulture Area that was first settled during the California Gold Rush in the nineteenth century, and settlers in the region began planting the first grapevines and producing the first wine soon thereafter. Suzy and Jim Gullett established Vino Noceto with a 1984 purchase of a 21-acre property and the subsequent 1987 acquisition of the neighboring 18.5 acre original homestead in Amador County. They quickly became "California's Sangiovese Specialist" after traveling around the world and searching for the right varietal for their terrior. 'Noceto' means walnut grove in Italian, and walnuts were a staple crop for the farm where the Noceto estate now stands. Noceto, Italy, near Parma, is the sister city of Suzy's native town of Walnut Creek. The wine is rich, juicy with aromas of confiture Black plum, Black currant, maple, and dried herbs on the nose. The flavors on the palate are supple strawberry-rhubarb, candied lemon rind, dried red currant layered with dried black plum skins, toasted vanilla, chicory and a dry finish. Pair with BBQ Ribs, pasta w/ tomato sauce, pecorino and gorgonzola cheeses, and grilled sausages.

2018 Sosie “Bear and Rooster” Red Blend Napa Valley



A blend of 56% Cabernet Franc and 43% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Stagecoach vineyard in Napa. Sosie Wines is owned by husband and wife duo Scott MacFigen and Regina Bustamante. They founded the winery in 2015 and are based in Sonoma, California. With a trip through France, Scott and Regina were inspired by Northern Rhone, and in particular Domaine de Gouye in Hermitage. There was no tractor in the vineyard and no forklift in the cellar, just a vertical press, circa 1880. To witness the winery in action is to think you've traveled back in time. This reverence for the past and noticeable restraint in wines from the Northern Rhone, created the backbone for which Sosie wines are built. Aged for 21 months in French oak barrels. Deep and concentrated, dark fruit, cedar, anise, espresso, crushed violets, plum, dark cherry, graphite, and mountain tannins. Pairs well pairing well with ribs, pasta salad, grilled beef, or other dishes with bold or earthy flavors.

2018 Long Meadow Ranch Merlot Napa Valley



How about this for history! President Ulysses S. Grant signs a land patent granting 640-acres to Civil War veteran E.J. Church, which becomes Long Meadow Ranch. Pre-prohibition the property grew grapes, apples, olives and hay are cultivated and brought to market by horse-drawn carriage. Prohibition brought everything to a halt. In the 1980's the Hall family bought the neglected property and turned it into a beautiful, organically farmed oasis. A blend of small Merlot blocks at our Mayacamas and Rutherford estate vineyards showcases the pleasant synergy of mountain and valley floor fruit. The 2018 opens with aromas of Bing cherry, cranberry and pomegranate with the slightest hints of vanilla and cinnamon. A very light sweet French oak profile, long soft tannins, and a luscious acidity makes this a versatile quaffer that will please most at your next social gathering. Pair with filet mignon, grilled skirt steak, margherita pizza, carbonara pasta, or Spanish jamon.
