2021 Chateau de Valcombe Blanc Costières de Nîmes, France



A blend of 70% Roussanne and 30% Marsanne. Costières de Nîmes is an AOC for wines that are produced between the ancient city of Nimes and the western Rhone delta in the south of Cotes du Rhone. Château de Valcombe, a familyowned property since 1749, is the southernmost estate in the Costières de Nîmes. Close to the Mediterranean Sea and planted on soils boasting the highest concentration of limestone in the region, Valcombe offers refined, concentrated wines with exuberant freshness and minerality. In 1791 the estate received official recognition from the revolutionary army for the quality of wines sent to the frontlines. Seducing nose of ripe pear and fresh citrus flavours. On the palate, a wide variety of citrus fruit flavors combine with a touch of honey and a hint of ripe apricot. The creamy and rich finish remains extremely fresh and elegant. Perfect with asparagus soup, salmon carpaccio, scallops, veal ribs, Cantal cheeses.

2017 Seven Oxen Zinfandel Paso Robles



Seven Oxen is a family-owned, estate winery producing smallbatch Rhone and Zinfandel wines. The Estate vineyard is located off of Kiler Canyon Road in the iconic Templeton Gap of Paso Robles' Westside. The tranquil 130-acre estate includes 26 acres of head pruned, spur trained vines. We keep our yield low and farm organically to guarantee the highest quality fruit possible, and take a minimalist approach at the winery to produce wines reflecting the unique character of the estate. Ten acres of Seven Oxen Vineyard are planted with Zinfandel. Four of these acres were planted in 2003 and make up the vineyard's oldest production. This easy-drinking zin has a clean, bright nose with notes of fig, dates, nutmeg, and cinnamon. Licorice, black pepper, black cherry, strawberry, and raisin on the palate with peach preserve on the finish. Pair with a burger, pizza, pasta, or braised beef short ribs.

2022 Paolo Scavino Bianco 'Sorriso', Langhe, Italy



Predominately Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc with a touch of Viognier. Paolo Scavino winery was founded in 1921 in Castiglione Falletto from Lorenzo Scavino and his son Paolo. Enrico Scavino together with the daughters Enrica and Elisa, fourth generation, run the family Estate. Through 70 years of work, Enrico Scavino has researched and purchased some of the most historic vineyards cultivated with Nebbiolo for Barolo to experience and show the uniqueness of each site. Fermented separately and aged six months in stainless steel. Malolactic fermentation is blocked to preserve the wine's freshness. 1500 cases produced annually. Fresh and charming nose with white flowers, sage, yellow and orange fruits in addition to mineral notes. The delicate flavors continue on the palate where a soft texture is combined with a sapid and cleaning acidity. Pair with fish, shellfish, creamy pastas, and chicken breast.

2020 Kinast Cabernet Sauvignon Gran Reserva, Lontue Valley, Chile



Lontue Valley is a sub-region (effectively the southern part) of the Curico Valley, in central Chile. Some of the country's most famous wine companies are based here, including Valdevieso and Echeverria. 1998 was the year when Carlos Kinast began working in the Wine Business, he has worked in different wineries as Commercial Manager, General Manager and finally as Commercial Director and shareholder of a winery. He has decided to sell their shares in the last winery and start his own winery with the name of Kinast Family Wines, beginning his family company following the successful path of their father in law Aurelio Montes one of the most important winemakers in Chile and the world. Expressive aromas of black currents, blackberries, cherries, roses and figs, hints of pine, dried herbs, and dark chocolate on the nose. The 12 month aging process in French oak barrels results in a complex wine with firm tannins and toasted notes with hints of spicy and smoky notes. Pair it with red meats, lamb chops and strong cheese.

2018 Sacacina 'Winter's Edge' Red Redwood Valley, Mendo



A blend of 50% Grenache and a field blend of Carianane and Colombard. Saracina Vineyards is the gateway to stunning Mendocino wine country. Tucked away near the headwaters of the Russian River and the foothills of the Mayacamas, our beloved estate is perched on pristine, sustainably farmed land. The Taub family has stewarded the land since 2001, committed to exceptional winegrowing. The Taubs' multigenerational story is deeply rooted in wine, as Marty Taub and his son David were built a successful wine import company in the 1970s. This unique, old-vine field blend is vinified from grapes picked from two single-vineyard sites on Nov. 6, 2018—post frost. From the Casa Verde vineyard, planted in 1944, we harvested a field blend of old-vine Carignane, Grenache, and Colombard. Casa Verde is dry farmed and certified organic with 75-year-old, head-pruned vines, planted on alluvial loam soils. Red berry-driven flavors, bright acidity, and smooth tannins. Pair with seared ribeye steak or a meaty, comforting stew.

2020 Gibbs Cabernet Franc Oakville, Napa Valley



The Gibbs family started off in Napa Valley growing walnuts, dates, and a small selection of grapes in the 1950s. That's when Dr. Lewis Gibbs Carpenter Jr., a lifelong farmer and psychologist with a history rooted in the cattle ranches of Gilroy, moved to Saint Helena and bought land on the valley floor. The 2020 Oakville Cabernet comes from a highly sought after vineyard in the heart of the valley. In fact, this vineyard is so sought after that this is the first and possibly last time they will get a chance to work with the fruit so they jumped at the opportunity. They blended some of this wine into their Napa Valley Cabernet Franc, but chose to set aside 6 barrels that were in a league of their own! Aromas of red current, black tea, graphite, violet and red cherry leap from the glass, complimented by subtle vanilla and spice notes imparted by French oak. The body is plush and velvety, showing ripe blueberry and dark cherry framed by dried

herbs, sage and earthy undertones. Pair with lamb chops or grilled pork ribs.
